Would you like to give back to the Prodeko community while meeting the next generation of talented students? Did you start your studies in 2016 or earlier? The Prodeko 60 Alumni Shadowing Programme offers a meaningful opportunity to share your experience, showcase your work and industry, and mentor students who are exploring their future careers.

In the programme, you will host one student for a shadowing day at your workplace, supported by a short pre-meeting to introduce your role and a post-discussion to reflect on the student's observations and career interests. You can volunteer to mentor 1–3 students on separate shadowing days. Students and alumni are matched based on professional interests, skills, and career aspirations to ensure relevant and valuable interactions.

Sign-ups for alumni are open from 7.2. to 7.3., with shadowing days taking place between 23.3. and 24.4. All shadowing takes place in Finland, and student travel costs are covered by the Prodeko Fund.

The programme is organized with a strong focus on professionalism and confidentiality. Students sign NDAs, complete confidentiality training, and comply with any company-specific requirements before participating. Our goal is to make participation smooth, safe, and respectful of your workplace responsibilities. The initiative has been planned together with the Prodeko Advisory Board, and we are committing with the care required for a student to shadow a listed company CEO.

13. Past events:

a. Prodeko Alumni fall meeting 4.12.2025

The Alumni fall meeting took place in Helsinki on December 4th. A new board was elected - the second year in a row with a vote.

It was decided that the membership fees and joining fees will be 0 euros also in 2026. In 2025, aTalent distributed their first dividends to owners. As a result, we have a slightly higher budget for our grand 60th anniversary year, compared to usual.

The Spring Meeting will be held in connection with the Prodeko Seminar on May 22nd.

b. Opening of Prodeko 60 year 7.2.

On February 7th, we opened the grand celebration, which will take the entire year. The event was organized in collaboration with Alumni, Guild and Department of Industrial Engineering and Management. We revealed the theme of the year - **Passion & Action for Growth**, the year's calendar of events, and networked with each other. The DIEM department gave us tours of the faculty and told us what's ongoing nowadays, in terms of research and teaching. 14. Greetings from Department

2026 is shaping up to be a great year at the department. On the occasion of the 60th anniversary of Prodeko and our TUTA program, we are working full speed on organizing a number of initiatives and events together with our students and alumni.

We have also decided that it should be part of our department's mission to help with getting growth back to Finland. We thus amended our mission to "Creating, scaling and transforming technology-based businesses".

I'm also happy to report that, as a department, we are already substantially contributing to growth and renewal. For example, last year we started several new research projects, together with companies, on the following topics: AI and strategy work, AI and leadership and the future of work, the impact of digital technologies on work communities, the role of AI for regulatory technology, and corporate-startup collaboration.

We have been well-connected with companies but are now connecting more closely with the public sector. Jukka Mäkelä, former Mayor of the City of Espoo, has started as executive-in-residence at our department.

We are also working on making sure our graduates get the skills they need for today's and tomorrow's working life. The skills on which we focus our development with new or renewed courses include AI, sales and personal development. We are also developing our offering in the area of technology entrepreneurship, and are a key contributor to the new Aalto Founder School.

15. Greetings from the Guild

Greetings from Prodeko, and happy start of the 60th anniversary year for us! The guild has had a great start to the new year and the board of '26 has started operating officially. Last week, as their final act the board of 2025 organized the traditional Guild Official's Exchange where new board members received their role reliks sealing the switch from 2025 to 2026.

Overall it's going to be an exciting year for the guild. With the anniversary year, the level of ambition in every event organized has been raised substantially. For alumni this can be best seen in the three main events of the year: the Prodeko 60 Kick-off, the Seminar, and Diskonttaus. Remember to register for the events early as the quotas may fill up fast. 16. aTalent update

aTalent's 2025 was a year of two very different halves: The first half (H1) was historically strong, delivering record-breaking results. However, during the summer and autumn the market slowed down significantly, and companies became hesitant with recruitment decisions due to uncertainty and widespread hiring freezes. Toward the end of the year, sales stabilized at around 40 opened assignments per month, and monthly performance returned to profitable levels.

For the full year, however, we ended slightly in the red, with a loss of about €25k. For context, aTalent's monthly profit fluctuation has historically ranged between €100k profit and €100k loss. Thanks to healthy retained earnings from previous years, we are still able to distribute dividends.

This past year's rollercoaster highlights how cyclical our industry is. The key objective of our current strategy period is to strengthen resilience. One important lever is expanding our recurring-revenue business and improving customer retention among larger accounts with a broader service portfolio. We are already seeing positive signs: our HR-as-a-Service offering has grown nicely and now represents 10% of our business volume. This provides a helpful buffer during weaker months, and we plan to continue scaling this segment. In terms of business volume, we reached our target almost exactly, with €3.9M in adjusted revenue (i.e., revenue excluding pass-through wages for temporary employees).

Our recruitment hit rate remained strong at 81%. When removing reasons unrelated to aTalent — such as clients canceling the recruitment need altogether — the success rate rises to 94%. The profile of candidates we place has also continued to shift toward more experienced experts, managers, and even executives. The average relevant work experience of the candidates we place is now close to 11 years — meaning we are no longer primarily talking about juniors.

The outlook for 2026 is very positive, with new assignments already opening above target levels. We also plan to strengthen our presence in next-generation leadership recruitments, an area where aTalent has the strongest networks in Finland.

On behalf of the entire company, I wish the whole Prodeko community a wonderful New Year! Feel free to reach out if you are looking for top-level talent to join your team.
