We've had a great Prodeko seminar in May. A lot of effort went into organizing the event from the students, and –led by Olivia Rönnemaa, this year's seminar czar– they did an amazing job! In case you weren't there (and if you were, this is a reminder), there are two things we launched at the seminar.

We launched the Prodeko Doctoral Research Partnership (ProDoc), which is a model for IEM alumni to pursue doctoral studies effectively alongside their professional careers (ideally including commitment from the employer to have time for PhD studies). Participating in the ProDoc program includes: doctoral courses, database access, software tools, frequent 1:1 instruction by professor(s), joint events, and a supportive faculty. The initiative is supported by the Prodeko Fund to facilitate and accelerate doctoral research among our alumni community. If you're interested, please contact Markku Maula (markku.maula@aalto.fi).

Thanks to all who have donated to the Prodeko Fund already! The Prodeko Fund supports the Prodeko community and helps the IEM department to carry out and fund activities that support impact in business and society through teaching, research and engaging with practice. As of now, the fund supports the following activities: Prodeko alumni community manager, Applied philosophy initiative and Esa Saarinen's legacy, TUTA Linkage courses (HealthTech, Energy and Defence Linkage), the ProDoc initiative, projects for students to support pitkä excu, and the Prodeko seminar. Donations are very important for us as we face strong financial pressures due to limited government funding and pressure to increase our output. Since 2019, our teaching volume has grown by 40% while government funding to the department has shrunk by 21%.
