1. Honorary Advisory Council of Prodeko - Speed Mentoring

2. Heikki Poutanen Leadership Award

We are happy to announce the Heikki Poutanen Leadership Award and the recipient of the inaugural award for 2025. The award is based on a donation by Heikki Poutanen, IEM alumnus who was accepted to the first IEM cohort in 1966.

The Heikki Poutanen Leadership Award is given by the Department of Industrial Engineering and Management to a student or recent graduate for their extraordinary contributions and achievements in leadership and people management. It can be given for acting in leadership roles or academic accomplishments in the field of leadership (e.g., bachelor's or master's thesis). The award will be given annually by a committee including the head of department and representatives from the Organizational Development and Leadership group at the department. The award also comes with a cash prize of 1000 EUR.

In the inaugural year the award is given to Olivia Rönnemaa, who is a 3rd year IEM student. Olivia has taken multiple leadership positions in different student organizations: as the Prodeko seminar czar she was responsible for organizing the 2025 Prodeko seminar on behalf of Prodeko; she is also head of global operations at Junction, which organizes one of the world's largest AI hackathons and as well as hackathons around the world in partnerships; and she was recently elected as the president of Aalto Entrepreneurship Society for 2026. She wrote her bachelor's thesis on the topic of female entrepreneurs in the startup ecosystem, identifying the barriers female leaders face in the startup ecosystem, synthesizing the leadership styles and approaches women tend to take in startups, and highlighting the importance of role models. Finally, Olivia is also a great example of personal development and how to grow into a leader by gradually taking on more and more responsibility.

The award is based on a generous donation by Heikki Poutanen, an alumnus from the TUTA/IEM program who was accepted into the inaugural class of the industrial engineering and management program at Aalto University in 1966. Based on his donation we established the Heikki Poutanen People Know It Better Leadership Fund, which is managed by the Department of Industrial Engineering and Management together with the Prodeko Fund. A committee with representatives from the department, Prodeko, Prodeko alumni and Prodeko advisory board administers the fund.
